WHEREAS, the cable industry through companies such as Time Warner Cable created C-SPAN in 1979 as a public service; and

WHEREAS, over the last 32 years C-SPAN has provided the American people an important window to the public policy process; and

WHEREAS, Time Warner Cable plays a critical role in bringing C-SPAN's national public affairs programming to the people of Charlotte, to educate and inform; and

WHEREAS, Charlotte will be one of the epicenters of American politics in 2012 when it hosts a national political convention; and
